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Abstract

Gulo W, (1982: 29) character is personality viewed from an ethical or moral point of view, for example a person's honesty, which is usually related to relatively permanent traits. Kamisa, (1997: 281) "character is psychological traits, morals or manners that differentiate a person from others, character, character. Having character means having character, having personality." Alwisol explains "the concept of character as a depiction of behavior by highlighting values (rightwrong, good-bad) both explicitly and implicitly. Character is different from personality because the concept of personality is free from values. However, both personality and character are in the form of behavior directed at the social environment, both are relatively permanent and guide, mobilize and organize individual activities". Character is a basic element that exists in each individual, which makes a person able to behave according to their personal character (Zubaedi, 2012). According to Doni Kusuma, it is the characteristics, nature, style, or traits of each individual that are different and also depend on where they were raised and how their environment was in the process of maturing. And elementary school is the most appropriate place to start the formation of a human character. Based on this statement, it can be proven that the application of Pancasila into learning in schools is

Qualitative researchers believe that truth is dynamic and can be found only through studying people through their interactions with their social situations (Danim, 2002).

According to Sugiyono, 2005 Qualitative research examines the perspective of participants with interactive and flexible strategies. Qualitative research is intended to understand social phenomena from the perspective of participants. Thus, the meaning or understanding of qualitative research is research that is used to research the conditions of objects. Natural where researchers are key instruments.
