Because when children see and imitate what their parents do, they should set a good example in front of the children as much as possible (9) Involve children in homework by teaching it slowly without coercion (10) Discuss the rules in the house between parents and children and agree on them without any element of coercion (11) Accompany children's learning and become a personal teacher at home.
