The independent curriculum is designed to overcome problems by formulating new policies that provide freedom to institutions and students in implementing the learning process(Ariesanti, Mudiono, & Arifin, 2023). The independent curriculum has positive and negative influences in improving the quality of student learning. The positive influence is that students become creative and innovative with learning support. These students are able to manage their learning better, apart from that, students also become independent. The independent curriculum is the answer to changes in educational conditions and is an effort so that Indonesia does not lag behind the education systems in other countries. Apart from that, the aspect of strengthening student profiles is a concern that is developed in the concept of independent learning. Because educating humans only to think rationally without being accompanied by moral and character education is the same as creating a threat in the world. There are three concepts of an independent curriculum, namely curriculum as substance, as a system, and as a field of study. Curriculum as a substance is a document that contains formulations of objectives, teaching materials, teaching and learning activities, schedules and evaluations. The curriculum as a system includes personnel structure and work procedures on how to compile a curriculum. The aim of curriculum as a field of study is to develop knowledge about curriculum and curriculum systems.(Nurwiyatin, 2022)The independent learning curriculum will create active learning. This program is not a replacement for programs that are already running, but to provide improvements to systems that are already running. The freedom to learn offered by the Ministry of Education and Culture is a simpler learning process, this includes: (1) A one sheet learning implementation plan means it is made simply and not complicated as before (2) A zoning system for accepting new students that is flexible in its implementation (3) National exams have been replaced with minimum competency assessments and character surveys (4) National standard school exams have been shifted to continuous assessments such as portfolios (group assignments, written work, practicums, etc.).(Oktaviani, Marini, & Ms, 2023).

Before the implementation of the independent curriculum, education in Indonesia had implemented several curricula, including the 2013 curriculum. The 2013 curriculum had various impacts on education in Indonesia. The positive

impact of the 2013 curriculum is that students have critical reasoning in every lesson and teachers are also required to be creative. Meanwhile, the negative impact is a decline due to changes in the curriculum. The difference between the 2013 curriculum and the independent curriculum is that in the independent curriculum the science and social studies subjects are combined into science, SBdP only focuses on one field of arts, for example fine arts, dance, etc. In the independent curriculum, teachers teach using modules, while in the 2013 curriculum, teachers teach using theme books, in which all subjects are mixed into one theme. The Republic of Indonesia's 2013 curriculum has more assessments than the independent curriculum, making it difficult for teachers. Due to the many shortcomings in the 2013 curriculum, the government created a new curriculum to answer current educational challenges. The new curriculum created by the government is the independent curriculum. The Minister of Education and Culture initiated the independent or independent learning curriculum with the aim of creating a pleasant learning atmosphere. Happy for teachers, happy for students, happy for parents and happy for everyone. Every curriculum change that is made always gives rise to a new curriculum, regardless of the many advantages of each educational curriculum, of course there are also those in that curriculum. Usually the advantages and disadvantages of each curriculum come from the foundation, components, principles, evaluation and curriculum development models. The positive effect of having an independent learning curriculum is that children do not learn the same thing, but this curriculum provides freedom. Not only that, the next independent learning program is related to the driving

organization program, which is expected to encourage the realization of driving schools. Merdeka Belajar is a pioneering policy initiated by the Minister of Education Nadiem Makarim with the aim of restoring institutions. There are quite a lot of changes in this independent learning curriculum compared to the previous curriculum, including school exams which are usually carried out according to national standards or what is often called USBN or UN being replaced with Assessment Exams, RPPs or Learning Implementation Plans being shortened to one page, as well as zoning for the Acceptance of New Students (PPDB) takes into account the inequality of access and quality in various regions. Based on the results of the discussion, it can be concluded that the independent learning curriculum is a habit of forming ways of behaving, processing, thinking, acting creatively in order to develop each individual by determining their own destiny. The Ministry of Education and Culture provides opportunities for schools to help create higher quality education by providing opportunities to change the curriculum and develop it according to needs.
