Issuance of Presidential Regulation number 87 article 2 of 2017 concerning Strengthening Character Education (PPK), PPK has the following objectives: (1) Building a nation with noble character, morals, toughness, tolerance and mutual cooperation (2) Forming human resources who have noble, competent and moral character (3) Improving the mutual administration and quality of educational outcomes (4) Producing individuals who respect and appreciate other people and are able to live in a heterogeneous society. Thus, the character of education is expected to be able to produce a generation of quality, able to face challenges, and have good character in interacting with the environment, including the digital era. Character education aims to ensure that students as the nation's successors have good character and morals, to create a just, safe and prosperous national life. The aims of education in Law Number 20 of 2003 concerning the National Education System which states that "National education functions to develop abilities and shape the character and civilization of a dignified nation in order to make the life of the nation intelligent, aims to develop the potential of students to become human beings who believe and are devoted to God. Almighty, noble, healthy, knowledgeable, capable, creative, independent and a democratic and responsible citizen(Princess, 2018).

Basic concepts of character education

The basic concept of character education is contained in Minister of Education and Culture Regulation No. 23 concerning the Development of Character Education in 2015. The aim of Building Character Education (PBP) is to: (1) Making the school a fun learning park for students, teachers and education staff (2) Develop good habits as a form of character education in the family, as well as in society (3) Making education a movement that involves the government, regional government, community and family (4) Develop a harmonious learning environment and culture between families, schools and society. Character is formed from activities that are carried out repeatedly and become habits. These habits are what stick and become a person's character. The cultivation and development of character in the school environment is a shared responsibility, not only of teachers but also of the cooperation of students and parents. However, character development at school is only a "supplement" for students. Where the family has a big responsibility in educating a child at home.

Principles of character education

According to the principles recommended by the Ministry of National Education, Dasyim Budiansyah, as quoted by Heri Gunawan, believes that character education programs in schools need to be developed based on the following principles: (a) Character education in schools must be carried out continuously (continuity), meaning that the process of developing character values is a long process starting from the moment students enter school until they graduate from school in an educational unit (b) Character education must be integrated through self-development and the culture of the educational unit, meaning character education is carried out by integrating all subjects (c) In fact, character values are taught through a process, knowledge (knowing), doing (doing) and finally getting used to it (habit) (d) The educational process is carried out actively and fun. Teachers must apply the principle of "tut wuri handayani" in every behavior shown. From the explanation of the principles of character education, according to the author, the most fundamental principles are the principles of continuity and integration because these two principles underlie the other two principles.(Julaiha, 2014).

Character Development and Formation of Students

The dynamics of understanding character education proceeds through three moments: historical moments, reflective moments, and practical moments. A historical moment, namely an effort to reflect the experience of humanity as it struggles to live up to the concepts and practices of education, especially in the ups and downs of developing character education for students according to the context of the times. Reflective moment, a moment in which through intellectual understanding humans try to define their experiences, try to see methodological, philosophical and principle issues that apply to character education. The practical moment, namely with the provision of conceptual theoretical understanding, humans try to find ways to effectively implement character education projects in the field. Character education is the process of forming personality, ways of thinking and human behavior that become habitual so that they become the basis of morality in living their lives. For this reason, the goals of education at every level are closely related to the formation of students' character. The goal of national education is a formulation of the qualities of Indonesian people that must be developed by each educational unit. Therefore, the formulation of national education goals is the basis for developing character education. A person's character in the process of development and formation is influenced by two factors, namely environmental factors (nurture) and congenital factors (nature).
