Meanwhile, the media that is created is the second function of learning media in terms of its historical development, namely as a means of communication and interaction between students and the media, and thus is an important learning resource. There are several other functions that can be carried out by the media. These functions include, providing knowledge about learning objectives, motivating students, presenting information, and stimulating discussion stated four functions of teaching media, especially visual media, including: (1) Attention Function; The core function of visual media is to attract and direct students' attention to concentrate on the lesson content related to the visual meaning displayed or accompanying the text of the lesson material (2) Affective Function; Namely the function of visual media which can be seen from the level of enjoyment of students when learning or reading text with pictures. Visual images or symbols can arouse students' emotions and attitudes, for example information regarding social or racial issues (3) Cognitive Function; Namely the function of visual media as seen from research findings which reveal that visual symbols or images facilitate the achievement of the goal of understanding and remembering the information or message contained in the image. (4) Compensatory Function; Namely the function of teaching media which can be seen from the research results that visual media provides context for understanding the text and helps students who are weak in reading to organize the information in the text and remember it again.

Benefits of learning media

In general, the benefit of media in the teaching and learning process is that it facilitates interaction between teachers and students so that learning activities will be more effective and efficient. Classification of learning media

There are various types of learning media that can be used in the teaching and learning process. must be able to choose the right type of learning media to be used in teaching according to the learning needs of students. Classifying media based on certain characteristics is known as media, namely:

- 1. Presenter media, consisting of:
 - a) Group one: Graphics, Printed Materials, and Still Images
 - b) Group Two: Silent Projection Media
 - c) Group Three: Audio Media
 - d) Group Four: Audio plus Silent Visual Media
 - e) Group Five: Living Pictures (film)
 - f) Group Six: Television, Multimedia Group

2. Object Media

Media objects are three-dimensional objects that contain information, not in the form of presentation but through their physical characteristics such as size, weight, shape, arrangement, color, function.

3. Interactive Media

With this media, students not only pay attention to the presentation or object but interact while following the lesson

Media Selection Criteria

The criteria that must be considered in selecting learning media are described as follows:

1. The intended use

What competency standards and basic competencies do you want to achieve? Does the goal fall into the realm of cognitive, affective, psychomotor, or a combination? What type of sensory stimulation is emphasized: is it visual, auditory, or a combination? If it's visual, is it necessary movement or simply visual stillness? The answer to this question will direct us to certain types of media, whether real media, audio, still visual, motion visual, motion audio visual and so on.

2. Media characteristics

Characteristics of the media, is the media we choose appropriate to the goals to be achieved? We will not be able to choose media well if we do not know the characteristics of each media well. Because the activity of choosing is basically an activity of comparing each other, which one is better and more suitable than the other. Therefore, before determining a particular type of media, understand well the characteristics of that media.

3. Time

How long does it take to provide or create the media that we will choose, and how much time is available/do we have? 4. Cost

The use of media is basically intended to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of learning. Therefore, the cost factor is a criterion that we must consider.

5. Availability

In selecting learning media there are several criteria used, namely:

- 2. Support for the content of lesson materials

 Learning materials that are facts, principles, concepts and generalizations really need the help of media to make them easier for students to understand
- 3. Ease of obtaining media The media used is easy to obtain, easy to make when teaching.
- 4. The teacher's skills in using it are expected to be able to interact with students when using this media.
- 5. Time is available to use useful media for students during teaching.
- 6. In accordance with the level of thinking of students. So that the meaning contained in it can be understood by students.

Use of Learning Media in the process of student development

In general, learning media has the following uses: (a) Clarify the presentation of the message so that it is not too verbalistic (in the form of written or spoken words) (b) Overcoming limitations of space, time and sensory power, such as: objects that are too large can be replaced with reality, images, films or models (c) Using appropriate and varied educational media can overcome the passive attitude of students (d) With the unique attitudes of each student, coupled with different environments and experiences, while the curriculum and learning materials are determined the same for each student, many experience difficulties when they have to overcome everything themselves.
