Therefore, a teacher has the right to be a coach in developing students' talents and interests. In the Big Indonesian Dictionary (KBBI) talent is a tool, or a sign that something will happen (KBBI; 2008; 122). Talents are traits that give indications of the abilities a person has, which through practice can be realized into real abilities, especially in a special field (Adek Nuarizal, 2021). Talent is a gift given to every child, regardless of whether they are black, tan, olive, rich or poor, from an educated family or not. Every child is special and unique. Talent is genetically stored magic, which will shine and reach its maximum potential if developed in the right way. Talent can be interpreted as innate ability which is potential that still needs to be developed or trained. Ability is the power to perform an action as a result of character and training. Ability shows that an action can be carried out now, while talent requires training and education so that an action can be carried out in the future (Iman, 2015). Talent and intelligence are two different things, but are interrelated. Talent is an ability that is inherent in a person. Students who have talent from birth and are structured or arranged in their brains. Talented students are students who are able to achieve high achievements because they have superior abilities. These abilities include: (1) intellectual abilities, (2) academic abilities, (3) creative-productive thinking abilities, (4) leadership abilities, (5) abilities in one of the arts, (6) psychomotor (sports) abilities (Indah Ayu Anggraini, 2020). Interest is a feeling of preference or interest and can also be interpreted as a great desire for something that a person has. If a student has a great interest in a subject, then he wants to know the material in depth until he understands it. In developing an interest in learning, clear sources are needed regarding the process of developing the child's interest. Apart from that, it is very important to know the characteristics of children's interests in order to develop an effective program for developing children's interests. So interest can be developed through learning, because through learning you can analyze information about education, positions and various types of work. Through learning a person will gain abilities in various things, such as language skills, counting, writing, drawing and others (Munib, 2021). Interest can be divided into two, namely personal interest and situational interest. Personal interest has a relatively stable personality, personal interest shows a specific desire, for example (1) interested in dancing, (2) interested in sports, (3) interested in technology, (4) interested in drama, etc. Meanwhile, situational interest is an interest that is developed due to several factors, namely the situation or environment, for example (1) information obtained through books,

magazines, the internet, radio or television, (2) the role in formal education, etc. There are definitions of interest according to experts:

- 1. Eysenck et al. (1972) defines interest as a tendency to behave that is oriented towards certain objects, activities or experiences, and this tendency does not have the same intensity between one individual and another
- 2. Witherington (1986) believes that interest is a person's awareness of something, someone, a problem or situation that is related to him. Without a person's awareness of an object, the individual will never have an interest in something
- 3. Hurlock (1986) defines interest as a source of motivation that will direct someone to what they will do if given the freedom to choose. If they see that something has meaning for them, then they will be interested in that something which will ultimately give rise to satisfaction for them
- 4. Drever (1988) defines interest into two meanings, both functional and structural. Interest in the functional sense shows a type of feeling experience called "worthwhileness" (usefulness) which is associated with attention to objects or actions (Wardani, 2011).

Students' talents, interests and creativity are among the very important factors to encourage the successful implementation of education. Talent is a person's basic ability to learn in a relatively short time compared to other people, but the results are actually better, interest is a drive or desire within a person for a certain object and creativity is a process of producing new things. Based on the fact that talent and interest are one of the factors that every teacher really pays attention to when teaching at school. If ignored, it will make it difficult to achieve optimal educational implementation results. Even talents and interests are components for the achievement of a process in learning and teaching for every teacher in school (Winanta, 2017). 1. Attention

5. Extracurricular activities

This activity is an activity which is outside of the subject matter to help develop students according to their needs, potential talents and desires through activities specifically organized by educators and educational staff who are capable and authorized at the school (Maulandari, 2023).

There are several factors so that learning runs well and can make the learning a success, namely facilities and infrastructure in the learning process and time in the learning process. Facilities and infrastructure can support the process of learning activities in schools such as printed books and so on.
