- 4. Dynamists, teachers not only raise enthusiasm but also become true leaders towards goals with great speed, intelligence and wisdom
- 5. As an evaluator, teachers must have the ability to assess expressed behavioral attitudes, expressed actions and struggles, and planned agendas.

In this case, the role of teachers in building students' awareness of citizenship at school is very important. Because building ethics and morals is really needed for the next generation of this nation, where all this requires initial awareness from students to obey the rules at school and follow them well.
