The following are the three main functions according to (Ministry of National Curriculum Center, 2010), namely; (1) Formation and development of potential (2) Repair and strengthening (3) Filtering. Character education through citizenship education has been regulated by National Education Government No. 22 of 2006 in (Indrawati, 2015) where citizenship education is one of the subjects that focuses on building character so that they are able to carry out their rights and obligations to become good, intelligent, creative, responsible and trustworthy citizens. Citizenship education plays a role in providing provisions for students through ancestral values and basic skills regarding civic life. Citizenship education has a role in forming good character education in elementary school students which can be implemented by teachers at school, namely through exemplary activities and habits in the school environment, such as: (1) Familiarize students with loving their homeland; (2) Get students used to discipline, such as wearing uniforms in full, arriving on time, doing assignments, not cheating on exams, carrying out class pickets according to their schedule, and being responsible for what they do; (3) Get students used to always minding their words, obeying teachers, and having a sense of caring for others. Based on the researcher's analysis above, character education taught in citizenship education lessons with appropriate upbringing and habits implemented daily will produce students with character. This is the basis for why character education in elementary schools is very important to be instilled through citizenship education lessons, because it has a very big role in human life with good character.
