In terms of terminology, national insight is the perspective and attitude of the Indonesian people regarding themselves and their environment which are diverse and have strategic value by prioritizing unity and oneness and respecting and respecting diversity in every aspect of national life to achieve national goals (Zulfikar and Permady, 2021). The national perspective is the perspective of the Indonesian people in viewing themselves and their environment by prioritizing regional unity and integrity in the implementation of social, national and state life. The national insight now feels to be something that is abstract and untouched and experiences a fundamental silting of meaning (Wawasan *et al.*, 2022). Through the Consolidation of National Insight we can maintain the Unity and Unity of the Nation (Coordinating Ministry for Politics, Law, 2016). As a result, many citizens have no loyalty to the country and no sense of national pride. If this situation continues, student nationalist sentiment will gradually be eroded. For this reason, nationalism must be seriously strengthened in the era of globalization. The national insight here is essentially a very strong desire to overcome all differences and discrimination together. Radicalism is adopted from the word "radix" which can be interpreted as "roots", then it is used as the essence of the

meaning of radicalism which is politically translated as an action that intends to change the system from its roots (Rulyansah, Wardana and Sari, 2018). According to the detection results of the National Counterterrorism Agency (BNPT), there are at least four characteristics that indicate a person is exposed to radicalism: First, intolerant (rejecting differences in beliefs); second, fanatical (considering that people who have different beliefs are wrong); third, exclusive (always want to be liked and prioritized); fourth, exclusive (always wanting to be prioritized and privileged).

As for radicalism movements, most of them appear in religious circles, the issue of radicalism is very sensitive to discuss because it relates to religious beliefs which can also lead to intolerance between religious communities, this causes conflict in society (Nandasari, Isnata and Irvan, 2023). In this study, which examines the definition of radicalism according to the BNPT, radicalism can be interpreted as the frequent use of violent behavior in spreading beliefs based on conservative understanding. For example, by spreading fear among people, terrorist attacks can be carried out in public places. Such a situation is contrary to the nature of the Indonesian state which gives the widest possible freedom to its citizens to choose their beliefs and protect the safety and comfort of its citizens. Therefore, there is an urgent need to strengthen nationalism in the younger generation to build an identity based on faith and belief in God Almighty and respect for diversity in the life of the nation and state. Therefore, strengthening nationalism is interpreted as an effort to empower oneself to fight extremism and reluctance to live side by side with people of different beliefs. This is very important considering that the Indonesian nation was not founded on the basis of the same cultural elements, the same religion, and the same race, but on the basis of the same destiny, so as to create a sense of wanting to unite under one sovereignty and set aside differences of different backgrounds for the sake of that purpose.
